Reference: Planning application 2010/0461 – Land East of Eastoft Moors Road, Eastoft.

Crowle Town Council seek you accept the following as rigorous objection to the above, and progress such to the planning committee.

1. The cumulative effect of MULTI-WINDFARMS is one of the major considerations of local authorities when determining applications.
2. In the past 18 months FULL APPROVAL has been attained for the following:
 - (a) 34 Turbines between Crowle and Keadby (the largest WINDFARM IN ENGLAND)
 - (b) 22 Turbines to immediate West of Crowle (2nd largest WINDFARM IN ENGLAND)
 - (c) 12 Turbines adjacent to the nearby village of Eastoft
 - (d) 16 Turbines to the immediate North of the Swinefleet and Crowle warping drain.
3. The above translates as the most concentrated number of turbines (in populated areas) in the whole of EUROPE.

Conclusion

In considering the above, it defies belief that R.W.E are attempting to persuade North Lincolnshire Council to grant further scoping studies for yet more turbines, hence we would urge the planning committee to reject the application on the grounds that the area is already massively over-subscribed.
